	American Bittern	Botaurus lentiginos	hidden in bogs, marshes, wet meadows, cattails, bulrushes, shallow ponds	amphibians, fish, insects, reptiles	hiding among cattails, feeding in marshes and ponds, brooding, feeding, and nesting in grasses, migrating south
	Mallard Duck	Anas platyrrhynchos	ponds, lakes, marshes, small river bends, bays, ditches, city ponds, canals, urban parks	insects, fish eggs, small fish, tadpoles, wild rice, berries, leaves, green plant shoots, grain	surface feeding in shallow water, flying away or diving to escape, building nest, leading ducklings from nest to water, migrating south
	Ruddy Duck	Oxyura jamaicensis	ice-free, inland lakes and ponds, freshwater marshes and ponds with marshy borders mixed with open water	pondweeds, algae, wild celery, seeds of sedges, smartweeds, and grasses, aquatic insects and their larvae, shellfishes, crustaceans	foraging in mud and water, searching for nesting materials, breeding near water, migrating south
	Bald Eagle	Haliaeetus leucocephalus	breeds in forested areas near large bodies of water, winters in coastal areas, along large rivers, and large unfrozen lakes	fish, large birds, mammals, carrion	scavenging, capturing, stealing prey, wading in water to catch fish, flying high to court, building nest in large tree,
	Northern Harrier	Circus cyaneus	open habitats such as fields, meadows, marshes, agricultural areas, riparian zones, undisturbed, open habitats with dense, low vegetation, wetland habitats, nest built on raised mounds	small mammals, voles, snakes, frogs, passerine birds, small waterfowl, carrion	flying high to court, hunting for food, protecting nest, migrating south
